1 RULES

1.1 1 RULES

1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising will be Category C.

3 ELIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 All skippers must have some kind of disability but will not be required to provide proof.

3.2 All skippers will be required to abide by Trapseat class rules.

3.3 All skippers must represent a yacht club that will take possession of the International Trapseat

Cup (ITC) if that Skipper happens to win the final.

3.4 Only skippers from the US are eligible to race in the Defenders Cup Series and only skipper from

countries other that the US are eligible to race in the Challenger Cup Series.

3.5 Completed registration forms and fees must be mailed to: Stanton Betts, 2648 Nansen Ave., San

Diego, CA 92122-3120 USA not later that 1 December 2006. Checks should be made out to:

3.6 Skippers may bring there own Hobie 16 Trapseat equipped boats. If such is not desired, contact

4 FEES

4.1 The entry fee for this regatta is three hundred dollars US (\$420.00) per team. This fee includes

dinner on 27, 28 and 30 December for the skipper and crew. Additional dinner packages for

non-competitors may be purchased at seventy dollars US (\$75.00) per person and must be

indicated on the registration form.

5 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

5.1 A qualifying series for Defenders and Challenger will be raced at the same times with the final

Championship series between the two winners to follow.

5.2 The qualifying series are scheduled for racing on 27-29 Dec with a total of three round-robins.

5.3 The final Championship series is scheduled for 30 Dec and will be the best-of five.

10.3 The Championship will be sailed between the winners of the defender and challenger divisions.

The winner will be the first boat to win 5 races.
