NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 All Participants shall comply with the CYA Code of Behaviour.

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Club 420, Laser II, 29'ers and 49'ers classes that represent an Ontario Sailing Club or Organization.
- 3.2 Participants must be 18 years or under as of December 31, 2006 to be eligible for the 18 and under category, and 23 years or under as of December 31, 2006 to be eligible for the 23 and under category. This age eligibility requirement applies to both crew members.

4 CLASSIFICATION

The ISAF Sailor Classification Code will apply.

5 FEES

- 5.1 Pre-Registration: required fees if registered on or before July 17, 2006.

5.3 The registration desk will be located in the main club house at the Etobicoke Yacht Club (the Club). To pre-register, print the appropriate registration form found on the Club web site, www.eyc.ca. Complete the registration form, and fax it, along with relevant credit card information to (416) 259-9808, prior to the pre-registration cut-off date.

6 SCHEDULE

6.1 Registration:

6.2 Measurement and inspection:

Boats may be measured and/or inspected at any time during the regatta.

6.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on July 29, 2006 is 1030 hrs and the first race on July 30, 2006 is 1000 hrs.

7 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall conform to their respective class rules and weights.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available after 1700 hrs on July 28, 2006 at the registration desk at the Club.

9 VENUE

- 9.1 Regatta is hosted by the Etobicoke Yacht Club, located at 300 Humber Bay Park Road West, Toronto, Ontario, M8V 3X7. Humber Bay Park Road is accessible from Lakeshore Boulevard, near Park Lawn Road.
- 9.2 Races will be held on Lake Ontario, south of the Club.
- 9.3 Free camping is available on club property and there are hotels/motels within 3 kms of the Club. Campers are required to be registered, as such, with the Club.
- 9.4 Each Participant will be provided with two breakfasts, on water drinks and snacks both days, a barbeque dinner on July 29, 2006 and a regatta T-shirt.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1 For the all classes rules 44.1 and 44.2 shall apply.

12 SCORING

- 12.1 Scoring shall be the Low Point System as in the RRS Appendix A, with the following exceptions.
 - (a) One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
 - (b) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (c) When from 5 to 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (d) When 7 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
 - (e) 12.1 modifies RRS Appendix A.

13 SUPPORT AND COACH BOATS

All support and coach boats shall be registered with the regatta and shall be marked with a pennant (as described in the Sailing Instructions) distributed at check in. Coach boats shall not interfere with nor communicate with boats which are Racing. It is the intention of the Race Committee to allow coaches time between races to communicate with the Participants.

14 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places at the Club.

15 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while Racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

16 PRIZES

Ontario Sailing Medallions for the top three finishers for each age group. Other awards may also be presented.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
