The clinic will be conducted by Ashley Lethbridge, an experienced optimist racing coach from the Buffalo Canoe Club.

We have planned a fun day with T-shirts, draw prizes, and terrific barbeque lunches at PCYC and a dinner Thursday. The Chief Racing Officer will talk to the kids before the race and there will be a debrief at the end of the day. There will be as many races as time and wind will allow so that that the kids get lots of experience.

There will be no protests from sailors, but the CRO can protest a competitor. A specific code of sailing etiquette will be explained by the CRO.

The cost is \$60.00 with a \$5.00 discount (\$55.00) for registrations for both days (Clinic and Regatta) and \$35.00 (\$30.00) for the regatta only.
