NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

- The regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing.

ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- To be eligible for UofT Sailing Club Inter-Collegiate Regatta 2007 the competitor must be enrolled in a post-secondary institution in the scholastic year ending beginning September 2007.
- The boats to be sailed are Club 420s White Sail.
- Your post-secondary institution does not have to have a team; your team will be the athletes that register under their institution.
- **You must inform the organising committee of your attendance by September 27, 2007; registration is not necessary at this point but please email sailing.club@utoronto.ca if you plan to attend.**

FEES

- The cost of the regatta is \$40.00 CAD per person as determined by the Canadian Collegiate Regatta Series (i.e. \$80.00 per boat).
- **The charter fee for each 420 is free, but a damage deposit of \$150.00 CAD per boat is required. The deposit can be made in the form of a cheque to the "Port Credit Yacht Club" or cash; the deposit will be returned at the end of the event should no damage be incurred.**

SCHEDULE

- Saturday September 29:
 - 0800 Registration opens
 - 1000 Registration closes
 - 1015 Competitors' Meeting**
 - 1100 First gun
 - 1700 No races shall be started after this time

- 2100 Social
- Sunday September 30:
 - 1000 First gun
 - 1400 No races shall be started after this time
 - 1530 Awards
- A maximum of 15 races will take place at the event.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- The sailing instructions will be made available upon registration.

VENUE

- A map showing directions to the Port Credit Yacht Club can be found on the Port Credit Yacht Club website at: www.pcytc.net
- Racing will be held in the waters of Lake Ontario adjacent to Port Credit Yacht Club.

THE COURSE

- The course to be sailed will be a windward/leeward course with the single Start/Finish line located in the centre of the leg.
- A boat shall not cross the Start/Finish line unless she is starting or finishing.
- The length of each race shall be approximately 20-25 minutes.

SCORING

- **The low-point scoring system shall be used for the regular fleet results.**
- The team scoring system shall be used in accordance to the scoring system agreed upon by the Canadian Collegiate Regatta Series Committee (pending).

PRIZES

- Prizes shall be awarded to the top three finishing boats.
- The UofT Sailing Club Collegiate Award will be granted to collegiate team with the best overall team score.

ACCOMMODATION

- Billeting will be made available to all competitors in need of accommodation. Contact Jason Hearst at sailing.club@utoronto.ca.
