



**NOTICE OF RACE
Club 420 Regatta
August 18-19 2008**

1. Rules

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to club 420 sailors
2.2 Eligible boats may enter by filling out the required forms and pay the registration fee at the registration desk.

3. Entry Fee

- 3.1 The entry fee of \$40 includes boat and trailer parking, launching, hauling and invitations to social events for skipper and crew. Checks must be drawn on a Canadian bank and made payable to the Royal Canadian yacht Club. Cash or VISA are also methods of payment allowed.

4. Schedule

4.1 Registration:

Must be received and processed by August 18th at 1000

4.2 Dates of Racing:

Monday August 18	1130	1 st warning signal (4 Races Planned)
Tuesday August 19	1100	1 st warning signal (3 Races Planned)

No warning signal will be made after 1500 on the last day of sailing.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the registration desk during registration times as per 4.1.

6. Venue

- 6.1 The racing area will be southwest of the eastern gap.

7. Courses

- 7.1 All courses will be a triangle windward – leeward course
7.2 Yachts shall leave windward marks to Port except when crossing finish line.
When finishing boats will pass between the leeward mark and the R/C boat.

8. Scoring

- 8.1 5 races are scheduled of which one is required to be completed to constitute a series.
8.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
8.3 When 5 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her races excluding her worst score.

9. Berthing

- 9.1 Boats shall be kept at RCYC Junior Club.

10. Prizes

- 10.1 Series prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew finishing first through third.

11. Disclaimer

- 11.1 The Organizing Authority shall require each competitor to sign a waiver for loss, damage or injury to persons or property occurring in conjunction with the regatta or on the property of the RCYC. The Organizing Authority, their members, employees, officers and/of agents shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or at sea as a consequence of the participation of any boat.
