### **Important Notice:**

The possibility exists that this event will be moved or cancelled with short notice. Please make sure you have contacted the organising authority prior to arriving at the venue for the event.

## RULES

- The regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing.

## ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- To be eligible for UofT Sailing Club Inter-Collegiate Regatta 2008 the competitor must be enrolled in a post-secondary institution in the scholastic year beginning September 2008.
- The boats to be sailed are Club 420s White Sail.
- Your post-secondary institution does not have to have a team; your team will be the athletes that register under their institution.
- Two athletes from different institutions may join to form one boat, but their final team score for their institution will be divided between the two institutions.
- It would be appreciated if you inform the organising committee of your attendance by September 18, 2008; registration is not necessary at this point but please email [sailing.club@utoronto.ca](mailto:sailing.club@utoronto.ca) if you plan to attend.

## FEES

- The cost of the regatta is \$20.00 CAD per person as determined by the Canadian Collegiate Regatta Series (i.e. \$40.00 per boat).
- The charter fee for each 420 is free, but a damage deposit of \$100.00 CAD per boat is required. The deposit can be made in the form of a cheque to the "U of T Sailing Club" or cash; the deposit will be returned at the end of the event if no damage be incurred.

## SCHEDULE

- Saturday September 20:
  - 0800 Registration opens
  - 1000 Registration closes
  - 1015 Competitors' Meeting
  - 1100 First gun
  - 1700 No races shall be started after this time
  - 1830 Dinner (included in registration)
- Sunday September 21:
  - 1000 First gun
  - 1400 No races shall be started after this time
  - 1530 Awards
- A maximum of 15 races will take place at the event.

### **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- The sailing instructions will be made available upon registration.

### **VENUE**

- A map showing directions to the National Yacht Club can be found on the National Yacht Club website at: [www.thenyc.com](http://www.thenyc.com)
- Racing will be held in the waters of Lake Ontario adjacent to the National Yacht Club.

### **THE COURSE**

- The course to be sailed will be a windward/leeward course with the single Start/Finish line located in the centre of the leg.
- A boat shall not cross the Start/Finish line unless she is starting or finishing.
- The length of each race shall be approximately 20 minutes.

### **SCORING**

- The low-point scoring system shall be used for the regular fleet results.
- Institutions will be ranked according to the U of T Inter-Collegiate Regatta Team High-Point scoring system which was used at the event last year and will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

### **PRIZES**

- Prizes shall be awarded to the top three finishing boats.
- The UofT Sailing Club Collegiate Award will be granted to collegiate team with the best overall team score.

### **ACCOMMODATION**

- Billeting will be made available to all competitors in need of accommodation. Contact Jason Hearst at [sailing.club@utoronto.ca](mailto:sailing.club@utoronto.ca), prior to September 18, 2008.
