ORGANIZING AUTHORITY HUDSON YACHT CLUB

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as they may be amended by this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Class association rules will apply for each fleet.
- 1.3. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. The regatta is classified Category A in accordance with RRS Appendix 1- ISAF Advertising code.

3. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRIES

- 3.1. Entry is restricted to youth sailors born January 1, 1991 or later, except for 29er's sailors who have to be born January 1, 1989 or later. Proof of age is required. Contact info@hudsonyachtclub.com or call 450-458-5326 with any questions regarding eligibility.
- 3.2. The regatta will be limited to the following classes of boats:

4. FEES

- 4.1. Entries and payment are due on or before July 1st, 2009. The entry fee of \$125 per person includes: 2 days of clinics, lunch on all four days, plus dinner on Saturday (extra dinner tickets are available).

5.2. The Final Regatta Schedule will be available at registration check in. A copy will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

6. REGISTRATION

6.1. Registration must be performed on-line.

6.2. No registration will be accepted after 08:30 Saturday July 25, 2009.

6.3. Registration for racing only will be accepted on Saturday July 25, 2009 before 08:30.

7. MEASUREMENT

7.1. During competition boats may be subject to inspection.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8.1. The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

9. VENUE

- 9.1. Training and Race Areas will be on the Lake of Two Mountains adjacent to the Hudson Yacht Club.

10. THE COURSES

- 10.1. The courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 10.2. All races will be approximately 45 min. in duration.
- 10.3. A minimum of 5 races is scheduled.

11. SCORING

- 11.1. The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A will apply as amended below.
- 11.2. Three races must be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.3. When five or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.4. When six or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12. SUPPORT BOATS

- 12.1. The access of coach and support boats will be restricted. Coach and support boat drivers shall register at the registration desk and on race days shall check in with the race committee on water.
- 12.2. Support boats shall be marked with Fruitbowl Coach Boat stickers.

13. BERTHING

- 13.1. Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

14. PRIZES

- 14.1. Keeper prizes will be awarded for first through third places in every qualifying fleet, minimum six boats per fleet, except the Opti Green Fleet.
- 14.2. Opti Green Fleet will receive participation prizes.
- 14.3. There will be a sportsmanship award in each class.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 15.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16. INSURANCE

- 16.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance covering an adequate amount.

17. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 17.1. Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the Clubhouse veranda.

18. ACCOMMODATION

- 18.1. A limited number of camping sites will be available at HYC. Allocation of camping sites will be on a first come basis on receipt of registration and fees.
