1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to Optimist and Club 420 sailors.
2.2 Eligible boats may enter by filling out the registration form and paying the registration fee in person at the Boulevard Club registration desk from 0900 to 1100 on Thursday, July 23.

3. Entry Fee, Lunches and Storage

- 3.1 There is no entry fee for this regatta. Limited parking and boat storage facilities may be available. Sailors should make advance arrangements with the Boulevard club should they require overnight storage of boats or trailers. Lunches are not provided.

4. Schedule

- 4.1 Registration must be received and processed by 1100 on Thursday, July 24.

6. Venue

- 6.1 The racing venue will be Humber Bay, off-shore from the Boulevard Club.

7. Courses

- 7.1 All courses will be a triangle windward leeward course.

8. Scoring

8.1 A boat's score will be the total of her race scores. There will be no drop races, regardless of the number of races completed.

9. Prizes

9.1 Prizes will be awarded to the sailors in the top three boats in both the Optimist and Club 420 classes.

10.1 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
