



Ontario Summer Games

Preliminary Sailing Instructions

August 10-13, 2010
Sudbury Yacht Club



1. Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

1.2 All participants shall comply with the CYA Code of Behavior. All participants are required to sign Ontario Sailings Code of Conduct http://www.ontariosailing.ca/media_lib/PDFs/Board_Governance_etc./Ontario_Sailing_Athlete_Code_of_Conduct.pdf

1.3 Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

2. **Notices To Competitors:** Will be posted on the Official Notice Board at the Sudbury Yacht Club.

3. **Changes To Sailing Instructions:** Any change to the Sailing Instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

4. Signals Made Ashore:

4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag pole.

4.2 When AP is displayed ashore, "1 minute" is replaced with "not less than 30 minutes" in the race signal AP.

4.3 When flag Y is displayed ashore, rule 40 applies at all times while afloat. This changes the Part 4 preamble.

5. Schedule

5.1 Boat check-in: Tuesday morning, August 10 at SYC and training day.

5.2 Dates of racing: Wednesday August 11- Friday, August 13

5.3 The maximum number of races is 20.

5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Wednesday August 11 is 1100.

5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Thursday, August 12 is 1030.

No new Warning Signal will be made after 1630 on Thursday.

5.6 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Friday August 13 is 1030.

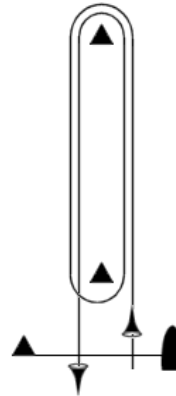
No new Warning Signal will be made after 1300 on Friday.

6. Class Flags:

Class	Flag
420	Numeral Pennant "1"
Radial	Numeral Pennant "2"

7. **Racing Area:** Racing will be held on Lake Ramsey as close as practical to the SYC.

8. **Course:** Windward Leeward twice around as shown in the diagram.



9. **Marks:** The description of the marks will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

10. The Start:

10.1 Races will be started by using rule 26 with the warning signal made 5 minutes before the starting signal.

10.2 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal boat and the port end starting mark.

11. **Time Limit:** The time limit for each race shall be 1 hour. Boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes rules 35, A4 and A5.

12. The Finish: The finishing line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal boat and the starboard end finishing mark.

13. Protests and Requests for Redress:

13.1 Protest forms are available at the race office, located at SYC. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered there within 45 minutes after the Race Committee docks.

13.2 Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held in the protest room, located at SYC, beginning at the time posted.

13.3 Notices of protests by the race committee or protest committee will be posted to inform boats under rule 61.1(b).

13.4 On the last scheduled day of racing a request for reopening a hearing shall be delivered

- (a) within the protest time limit if the requesting party was informed of the decision on the previous day;
- (b) no later than 30 minutes after the requesting party was informed of the decision on that day.

This changes rule 66.

13.5 On the last scheduled day of racing a request for redress based on a protest committee jury decision shall be delivered no later than 30 minutes after the decision was posted. This changes rule 62.2.

14. Scoring:

14.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply. RRS A4.1 table is modified to read 0.75 points for first place in Low Point System.

14.2 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

14.3 Discarded Races:

- (a) Fewer than 5 races completed – no drops.
- (b) 5 to 9 races completed – 1 drop.
- (c) 10 to 14 races completed – 2 drops.
- (d) 15 to 20 races completed – 3 drops.

15. Replacement of Crew or Equipment:

Substitution of competitors, damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed without the prior written approval of the protest committee. Requests for substitution will be made at the first reasonable opportunity.

16. Prizes:

Ontario Summer Games Medals will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each class and Ontario Sailing will designate the winner of each fleet "Ontario Sailing Junior Provincial Champion".
