1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

- The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting
- Sailing Instructions
- Racing rules as defined in Appendix BB *Experimental Kiteboard Competition Rules*

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all kite racers. Racers must complete a Registration form and sign the appropriate Waiver form.
- 3.2 Eligible racers may enter online at www.kiterider.ca or by completing the entry form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Kiterider Canada – 1921 Carriage Court Orillia, ON L3V 6H2 by September 15 or in person at registration on September 16, 2011 before 11:00AM

4 FEES

Entry fee of \$40 per kite racer is required fees include the following:

- *Competition Races*
- *Race T-shirt*
- *3 lunch vouchers to the Crowd Inn or Lobbe's*

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration:
Friday September 16th – 9 am – 11 am
Skippers Meeting September 16th – 11 am
- 5.2 Dates of racing:
Friday Sept. 16 – Race 1 – 1 pm start followed by race 2 and 3
Saturday Sept 17 – 1st race of the day 11 am
Sunday Sept. 18 – 1st race of the day 11 am
No race to start after 2pm
- 5.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Friday Sept 16 is 12:54 pm and each day after is 10:54 am.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration on Friday September 16th at Sauble Beach – main beach (in front of Lobbe’s).

7 VENUE

The event will take place in the town Sauble Beach www.saublebeach.com with racing off Sauble Beach on Lake Huron located on the west coast of the Bruce Peninsula.

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be a mix of the following:

- Windward /leeward (with or without an offset mark or gates)
- Box-course
- M-course
- Triangle (with or without a windward/leeward)

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

The Scoring Penalty, rule 44.3, will apply - 360° Turn Penalty.

10 SCORING

10.1 Scoring shall be in accordance with Appendix BB – Alternative Low Point System

10.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.3 Discards shall be as follows:

1 - 3 races	0 discards	11 – 15 races	3 discards
4 – 6 races	1 discard	16 or more races	4 discards
7 – 10 races	2 discards		

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be given in the following categories:

- Masters > 50
- Men’s Open
- Women’s Open
- Juniors (under 18)
