NOTICE OF RACE

Important Notice:

The possibility exists that this event will be moved or cancelled with short notice. Please make sure you have contacted the organising authority prior to arriving at the venue for the event.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association will apply.
- 1.3 The Club 420 Class Rules will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 To be eligible for the U of T Sailing Club Canadian Collegiate Regatta 2011 the competitor must be enrolled in a post-secondary institution in the scholastic year beginning in September 2011.
- 2.2 The boats to be sailed are Club 420s (White Sail only); to be provided by the host club.
- 2.3 Your post-secondary institution is not required to have a recognized sailing team; for the purposes of this regatta, the institution's team will consist of the athletes that register under the name of their institution.
- 2.4 Two athletes from different institutions may join to form one boat; however, their final team score for their respective institutions will be divided between the two.
- 2.5 The competitors must inform the organising committee of their intent to attend via email to uoft.comp.sailing@gmail.com by Monday, September 19th, 2011 at 11:59pm. Registration is not required at that time.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The cost of the regatta is \$20.00 CAD per person (i.e. \$40.00 per boat).
- 3.2 The charter fee for each 420 is free; however, a damage deposit of \$100.00 CAD per boat is required. The deposit can be made in the form of a cheque to the "U of T Sailing Club" or cash; the deposit will be returned at the end of the event if no damage is incurred.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration:
Saturday, September 24th from 0900 to 1000 hrs

- 4.2 A Competitors' Meeting will be held at 1015 on Saturday, September 24th
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday is 1100 hrs and no warning signal will be made after 1700 hrs
- 4.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Sunday is 1000 hrs and no warning signal will be made after 1400 hrs
- 4.5 There will be a dinner provided at 1830 on Saturday.
- 4.6 The awards ceremony will take place at 1530 on Sunday.
- 4.5 Number of races:
A minimum of 1 race will constitute a series.
A total of 16 races are scheduled, with no more than 10 to be sailed on Saturday.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will be made available at 0900 hrs on Saturday, September 24th at the registration desk.

6 VENUE

- 6.1 A map showing directions to the National Yacht Club can be found on the National Yacht Club website at: http://www.thenyc.com/about_location.php?sub=8
- 6.2 Racing will be held in the waters of Lake Ontario adjacent to the National Yacht Club.

7 THE COURSE

- 7.1 The course to be sailed will be a windward/leeward course with the single Start/Finish line located in the centre of the leg.
- 7.2 A boat shall not cross the Start/Finish line unless she is starting or finishing.
- 7.3 The length of each race shall be approximately 20 minutes.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 The low-point scoring system shall be used for the regular fleet results.
- 8.2 Institutions will be ranked according to the U of T Canadian Collegiate Regatta Team High-Point scoring system which will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

9 PRIZES

- 9.1 Prizes shall be awarded to the top three finishing boats.
- 9.2 The U of T Canadian Collegiate Cup will be granted to the Canadian collegiate team with the best overall team score.

10 ACCOMMODATIONS

- 10.1 Billeting will be made available if possible to all competitors in need of accommodation. If billeting is required, please contact the U of T Sailing Club at uoft.comp.sailing@gmail.com, prior to Monday, September 19th, 2011.
