NOTICE OF RACE **(subject to Amendment)**

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to: 29er, 29er XX, 49er, Club 420, 2.4mR, Contender and any One Design fleet with 4+ boats.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form and sending it, together with the required fee, to: The National Yacht Club, 1 Stadium Road, Toronto, Ontario M5V 3H4, (fax) 416-260-8780, (e-mail) programs@thenyc.com.

3.3 Registration fees:

July 7 – July 14	\$ 120.00	\$ 140.00

Note: Registration fees are refundable prior to July 6, less an administration fee of \$25.00. After July 6, no refunds shall be granted.

3.4 The registration fee includes two days of racing, a regatta dry-fit t-shirt, and dinner on Saturday evening. Lunches are not provided.

4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Registration will take place on Friday, July 13, 2012 from 1800 to 2000 and Saturday, July 14, 2012 from 0830 to 0930.

4.2 Racing will take place on Saturday, July 14 and Sunday, July 15.

4.3 A total of twelve (12) races are scheduled with no more than seven (7) to be sailed on Saturday. One (1) race constitutes a series.

4.4 There shall be a competitors meeting at 1000 on Saturday.

4.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1130.

4.6 There shall be no starting signals after 1500 on Sunday.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available Friday, July 13, 2012 at the National Yacht Club office.

6 THE COURSE

For all fleets except the Contender Class, the course to be sailed will be a windward-leeward located south of Ontario Place. The Contender Class will sail a triangle-windward-leeward course. Each race shall last approximately 25 to 30 minutes.

7 SCORING

7.1 Races will be scored using the Low Point Scoring System.

- 7.2 (a) When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from five (5) to ten (10) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When 11 races or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

8 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered with the Organizing Authority prior to leaving for the Race Course. There shall be no fee for support boat registration. Dinner for coaches and parents will be available for a TBD price. The National Yacht Club Restaurant will also be open.

9 BERTHING

9.1 Boats that are hauled shall be kept in their assigned places in the dry sail area.

9.2 Boats that remain in the water shall be kept in their assigned NYC basin location.

10 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

10.1 All boats shall be hauled at the end of each day, unless permission is obtained from the Race Committee.

10.1 Priority will be given to 2.4mRs to be left in the water overnight.

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: first, second and third place for each fleet.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300 per event or the equivalent.

14 AMENDMENTS TO THIS NOTICE
